



PRESS BRIEF

Ref. Bisra PS Case No.- 163, dt..27.06.2026, U/S- 326(f)/324(5)/109(1) BNS.

On 27.06.2026 at about 08.05 AM, the IIC, Bisra Police Station received information regarding a fire incident at Village Jara Toli, Santoshpur, in which a 27-year-old woman, sustained grievous burn injuries and had already been shifted to the hospital by her family members for treatment. Immediately upon receipt of the information, the IIC, Bisra Police Station, along with police personnel and the Scientific Officer, rushed to the spot and initiated a thorough investigation. During the preliminary enquiry and scientific examination of the scene, it was established that the incident was not accidental in nature but a deliberate act of arson committed by unknown person.

Taking the incident with utmost seriousness, the Superintendent of Police, Rourkela, constituted a special investigation team and issued specific directions for the immediate identification and apprehension of the person involved. The investigation was conducted on a war footing by combining scientific evidence, technical analysis, field intelligence, and sustained interrogation. The statement of the victim was also recorded during the course of investigation.

As a result of the prompt, coordinated, and professional efforts of the investigating team, the accused person namely Rajat Kiro, S/o.- Pradeep Kiro of Vill.- Kinjirkela, Dist.- Sundargarh involved in the offence was identified and apprehended within a remarkably short span of time after the occurrence, demonstrating the commitment, efficiency, and swift response of Rourkela Police in ensuring that offenders are brought to justice without delay.

The investigation is in progress, and all legal formalities, including early submission of the charge sheet, will be completed expeditiously to ensure effective prosecution.

Rourkela Police remains firmly committed to the swift investigation of heinous crimes, prompt apprehension of offenders, and ensuring justice in accordance with law.
